Main Menu



Menu	Description
① SD Card	Select SD card drive and organize play list.
② File	Select individual recording file. Non-English characters are not allowed in the path name where the file is stored.
③ Version	Display the current version of the PC viewer program.
④ Report	Write a report on the accident video. Export individual camera channels.
⑤ Capture	Capture the currently playing front camera video.
⑥ Setting	Settings of the dashcam.
